**NEW ADULT BIBLE FELLOWSHIP GROUP  
FOR NEW MARRIEDS**

A new Adult Bible Fellowship group will begin on Sunday April 3<sup>rd</sup>, targeted to minister to "Newly Married" couples (in the first 5 years of marriage) and those engaged to be married within the year. The group will be led by Rob and Stacy Foster, and co-led by Matt and Kalie Cannon.

When Rob and Stacy were asked why they were willing to help launch this group, they cited how important their ABF was to them when they were first married. Rob and Stacy said: "The studies we did and the friendships made in our new married ABF group helped us build a strong foundation for the first five years of our marriage. After praying about it, we believed God was directing us to now help others." Rob and Stacy made it clear that they are not "marriage experts", but the studies they did together early on in the first five years were so helpful that they in turn want to facilitate the sharing of that same information.

Their mission is to prepare married couples for ministry within the Church by studying God's design of Christian marriage. This group will study four different aspects of marriage: love, finances, family and ministry. One thing Rob and Stacy were quick to add, "we are grateful for this opportunity to lead the young marrieds because we love to review the studies we did early on in our marriage. We are benefitting from this study just as much as the "younger" couples.
